The Wheatland Township Fire Department has had 99 runs as of May 8th. 78 were medical calls and the remainder were fire calls. The department is still looking for available persons who are interested in joining the fire department or rescue personnel. Please join us at the fire department on Thursday evenings at 7pm if you are interested. Paid training is available. In May we will be holding our annual fire department poker run. This is where predetermined difficult to find addresses are given to our personnel to drive rescue vehicles to and obtain a poker card. Then the first team to arrive with the winning poker hand wins a prize. This allows us to be out in the community assessing where addresses are located to aid in faster response times. Also we give away small prizes to the addresses where we stop, for the trouble of allowing us to drive in their driveway with our large rescue vehicles. If you happen to see us out and about in May and don't see a fire, then we are training for faster response times.
