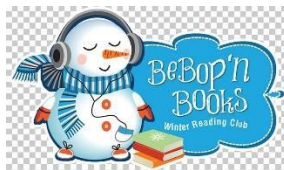

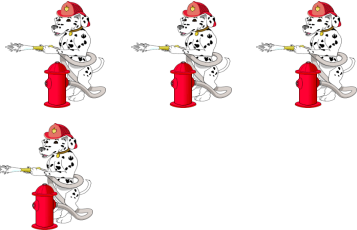

Has some new officers, appointed by the new Fire Chief Jason Stadtfeld, replacing Fire Chief Kevin Thiel after 7 years of leadership. We have been busy interacting with the community, hosting our first Fire & Safety Day on October 15th at the town hall and park. We gave away fire extinguishers to every household that attended. We had some wonderful kid's games, prizes, and a great little luncheon. Our fire personnel did some fire demonstrations on how to use the fire extinguishers, how we tear down a car for extraction of car accident victims, how a fire behaves and the importance of closing doors in your home to prevent the spread of fire. We also had some free literature from FEMA regarding what to do in an emergency, helping kids handle disaster, how to prepare for a power outage and several other FEMA brochures. We made our annual visit to St. Michael's School and did some presentations with games about fire safety to preschoolers- 2nd grade to help celebrate Fire Safety Month. We also participated in the Trunk or Treat at Janowicz Funeral Home on Oct. 22nd. We have been busy with Fire Safety Awareness month and have also answered 208 calls to date. We could not do all this without the volunteers of Wheatland Township Fire & first responders, but we're eagerly looking for more members.
