Wheatland Township DDA

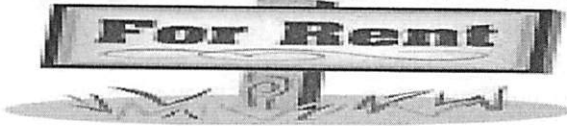

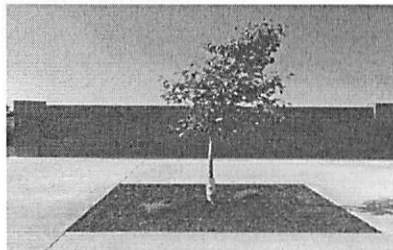
