Due to Proposal 2022-2 passing, Early Voting for all Governmental Elections is now required. Wheatland Township Residents will be able to:

1. VOTE ON ELECTION DAY AT THE TOWNHALL
2. VOTE ABSENTEE BALLOT THROUGH THE MAIL
3. EARLY VOTE 9 DAYS BEFORE THE ELECTION AT BIG RAPIDS TOWNSHIP

We are always looking for Election Inspectors. Please contact the office if interested.

However, we (Kim Thiel, office assistant, and Mary Karcher, clerk) both have families and grandma days and parent's dr. appt may require us to work at a different time than our scheduled hours. We do have the Dropbox outside of the main entrance of the twp. hall for your convenience to put election mail, taxes, sewer bills, hall/park rentals and any other twp. business that you may need to get to us. We do send receipts to you with ANY money that is put in the Dropbox so you know we received it. We have an answering machine at the hall and return messages as quickly as we can and my cell phone is at the top of this newsletter for any urgent messages. Thank you for understanding that our families will always come first and we will get back to you as soon as we return to the office. Next year will be a big **ELECTION** year for our township as well as our country. Every 4 years your township board must be elected. If you are interested in running for a position (Supervisor, Clerk, Treasurer, or Trustee) please call the office to get the appropriate paperwork (to be put on the ballot) by April 10, 2024.
